HORSE TEMPERATURE CHART

- Horse temperatures are to be taken twice per day and recorded in the chart below.
- This sheet should be placed on the horse’s stall door so it can be easily accessed and monitored. The temperature chart must be available for review by the EC Steward(s) upon request for any horse competing under EC rules.
- Any temperature found to be above 38.9°C in a quiet, resting horse is to be reported to the show office and/or horse show veterinarian (if on site).
